Maintaining session data during your visit (e.g., keeping you logged in).

Enabling necessary functionality that allows our website to operate efficiently.

By using our website, you agree to the use of these essential cookies. You can disable cookies through your browser settings, but please note that this may affect the functionality of our website.

4. HOW WE PROCESS YOUR PERSONAL DATA

Your personal information is processed only for the following reasons:
